CONTROLLED DRUGS & PENALTIES

Contained in the Misuse of Drugs Act (CAP 283) of the Laws of Antigua and Barbuda (hereinafter "the Act") are three classes of drugs (A, B and C) and part of the ONDCP's mandate is to enforce the aforementioned statutes. The Law permits an ONDCP officer to detain anyone suspected of producing, supplying, using, exporting and importing of dangerous or otherwise harmful drugs. Pursuant to Section 3 Part I-IV of "the Act" the following lists are Controlled Drugs listed by classes.
